



## 2023-2024 PROGRAM COSTS FOR DEGREE-SEEKING STUDENTS

The following tables provide an ESTIMATE of minimum expenses for each academic program at UNC-Chapel Hill for the academic year. Students requesting a Form I-20 for F-1 status are required to present funds immediately available for the first year of study and must submit financial support documentation covering at minimum the amount listed below (under “TOTAL”). If bringing any dependents in F-2 status (spouse and/or children under 21), students must show additional funding for each dependent as indicated below.

Students applying for J-1 status must provide proof of funding for the duration of the program for themselves and any accompanying dependents.

NOTE: Annual North Carolina state-mandated tuition increases may occur just prior to registration. Amounts below are estimates only and are subject to change. Students should also expect and plan for an increase in expenses of up to 5% each year.
